New service with LRS will start on May 2, 2022. However, public works will start delivering waste carts during the last two weeks of April. These carts will be placed at curbside, and should not be used until the first week of May.

LRS is excited to become the Village of Sheffield's new residential waste hauler, starting on May 2, 2022. We have a great appreciation for the high standards Sheffield residents have when it comes to service, quality and value. We look forward to exceeding those expectations. LRS is an Illinois based company with a local operation established nearby in Atkinson! Under the Village's new contract with LRS, residents will see new service enhancements.

This correspondence includes important information that will answer basic questions and explain your new services in greater detail. We hope that you will keep it handy, and use it as a reference point whenever.

WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

All Sheffield residents will be provided with one 95-gallon waste cart at no cost. This cart will be serviced weekly from the roadside.

All carts should be placed at roadside no later than 6AM on your service day. LRS recommends that carts are placed out for service the night before. Although LRS strives to keep a consistent pick up time, weather and staffing can alter pick up times.

All waste should be bagged and placed inside of the provided LRS cart with the lid closed to ensure safe collection and to help maintain a clean neighborhood appearance. **When placing your cart at the roadside place the cart at least 3ft from mail boxes, vehicles and other obstructions. The lid should face the road with the handle facing your home.** Proper cart placement will help the driver navigate safely and efficiently through your neighborhood!

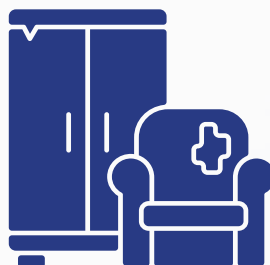


EXCESS GARBAGE

For trash that does not fit in the cart, LRS will provide service as needed, scheduled at an agreed upon per-yard basis billed from LRS directly to the resident.

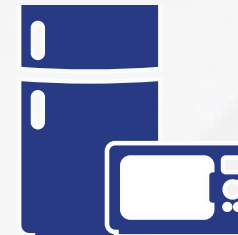
BULK ITEM

If a single household item is too large to fit in a cart then it is considered a bulk item. LRS will accept one bulk item each week! Please place the bulk item next to your trash cart on your regular scheduled collection day. **If the item is heavier than 50lbs please contact LRS to schedule the collection with our customer experience team so they can provide adequate equipment to handle the item safely.** This new weekly bulk item collection will replace the bi-annual cleanup program previously provided by the Village.



WHITE GOODS

LRS will provide collection of major appliances, including but not limited to ovens and refrigerators for a fee of \$25.00. White goods must be scheduled with LRS because these regulated materials do not go to the landfill and require separate collection.

ADDITIONAL CARTS

Should you need additional cart capacity on a permanent basis, the Village will provide one for a small fee. Please contact Village Hall for more information.
