

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-06-12-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO TEMPORARY RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TENTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF SHEFFIELD:

SECTION 1: The Village Code of the Village of Sheffield is hereby amended by adding a new Division 5 to Chapter 9, which is as follows:

TEMPORARY USE OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND TENTS:

9-5-1 **Penalty:** If any person shall violate any provision of Division 5, such person shall be fined not less than \$200 nor more than \$750. Each separate day that a violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

9-5-2 **Definitions:** The following words, terms and phrases when used in this Division shall have the following meanings:

- a. **Recreational Vehicle.** The definition for recreational vehicle shall be the definition contained in 625 ILCS 5/1-169 or, if that section is changed, whatever provisions contained in the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code define a recreational vehicle.
- b. **Tents:** A tent is defined as a portable structure covered or enclosed with canvas or similar materials and supported by poles.

9-4-3 **Temporary use of Recreational Vehicles or Tents:** A recreational vehicle and/or tent may be temporarily used as provided for within this Section. Only one recreational vehicle and one tent may be located on each lot within the Village. A recreational vehicle and/or tent may not be kept on any lot zoned for residential use within the Village for more than a total of two weeks during each calendar year. Further, if the occupant at a primary residential structure located on the property on which the recreational vehicle and/or tent is located has an illness that requires the occupant of the primary residential structure to receive temporary care, an extension of up to 30 days may be granted by the Village President. In order to obtain this extension, upon written request for the extension accompanied by a written note from a duly licensed physician confirming that the occupant of the principal structure requires services of a caregiver, up to six (6) 30-day extensions may be granted in a calendar year. In the event that a recreational vehicle and/or tent is placed on any property within the Village pursuant to this section, the Village shall be notified in writing of any stay that is in excess of two consecutive days. All occupants, guests and invitees of the recreational vehicle and/or tent must use



either the toilet facilities located within the recreational vehicle or the toilet facilities that are connected to the Village sanitary sewer system that are located within the primary residential structure located on the property upon which the recreational vehicle and/or tent is located.

SECTION 2: If any section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication thereof as provided by law.

SECTION 4: The Village Code of the Village of Sheffield, as amended by this Ordinance, shall remain in full force and effect and all previous amendments to the Village Code shall remain in force and effect except as modified by this Ordinance.
